ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING

Presbyterians have given generously to the One Great Hour Of Sharing since the first offering was taken in 1949. We believe that concern and active involvement are the cornerstones of our commitment to Christ and to our brothers and sisters in need. Through our gifts to the O.G.H.S. we share actively in the process of rebuilding lives, easing the world hunger crisis, and providing for self-development.

Banks have been given to our children and an envelope is available for families for your offering. Let's celebrate God's love. Remember that love has "no strings attached". Our offering will be dedicated at Palm Sunday worship.

One Great Hour of Sharing in Action- Through our One Great Hour of Sharing dollars, we help families of the Wu-Lai community in Taiwan. A Presbyterian Hunger Program grant provides milk goats and training in goat management so that these farm people may stay on the land instead of being forced into the cities to find jobs. In the West Indies, our dollars enable the Presbyterian Hunger Program to support the Food and Nutrition Program in Dominica. This project seeks to increase the availability of meat and eggs for home consumption by introducing poultry and pig farming. Through our sharing, the Prebyterian Hunger Program enables-people to improve their nutrition and their lives.

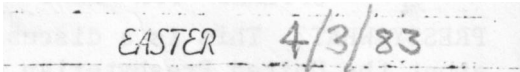
We will also participate in the sacrament of Baptism. Don and Marilyn Schmidt will present their children Brian and Laura to be baptized on that morning.
