Calling a new pastor is a vital event in the life of our church. It is a time for choosing our collective future. This moment provides an important opportunity for us all to assess together who we are, where we see ourselves going and what are the attributes of a leader who will help TPC live into its future. Beginning Monday, August 1 and throughout the month of

August, the Session is asking all members to take a survey that will assist this change. It not only asks several sets of questions about TPC's current ministry and your own involvement, but importantly seeks your input on pastoral leadership and your vision for our future.

The survey is primarily online, but a paper version of the survey will be available for those who prefer it. The survey is completely anonymous. There will be a link on the TPC website that will take you to it. It is a long survey, you should expect to spend at least 30 minutes taking it. If you have insufficient time to complete the survey, note the section you are on and exit the survey. When you have time to complete it, page forward to the location where you stopped and continue answering the questions. Your earlier answers are automatically saved as you complete each section. We ask that all members complete the survey by the end of August. Results will be shared with the congregation and importantly will be used to create the next step of the transition process - a Mission Information Form.

The survey will be available throughout the month of August. We strongly encourage each individual member to take it.
